**The A1(M) Motorway (Junction 15 Sawtry, Cambridgeshire)
Northbound Exit Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic)
Order 2013**

Made - - - - 25th November 2013

Coming into force - - 2nd December 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1(M) Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway (Junction 15 Sawtry, Cambridgeshire) Northbound Exit Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 2nd December 2013.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 7 hours starting at 22:00 hours on Friday 6th December 2013 or on any subsequent day (other than a Saturday or Sunday) until works to renew an overhead gantry sign have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the exit slip road from the northbound carriageway of the A1(M) Motorway at Junction 15, Sawtry.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used in connection with the works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance, traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes.
