**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A50 Trunk Road (Foston to Hilton, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - *30th December 2013*  
*Coming into force* - - *6th January 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A50 Trunk Road (“the A50”), and connecting roads is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road, and two of those connecting roads between Foston and Hilton in the County of Derbyshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) , hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A50 Trunk Road (Foston to Hilton, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on Monday 6th January 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road”

means –

- a) the eastbound carriageway of the A50 from its junction with the slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the A511 and Packenham Boulevard, east of Foston to its junction with the slip road leading from its roundabout junction with the A516 and Willowpit Lane at Hilton; and
- b) the westbound carriageway of the A50 from its junction with the slip road leading to the roundabout junction of the A516 and A5132 Derby Road at Hilton to its junction with the slip road leading from the roundabout junction of the A511 Uttoxeter Road, east of Foston;

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(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

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“a slip road”

means –

- a) the slip road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the A50 from the roundabout junction of the A511 and Pakenham Boulevard, east of Foston; and
- b) the slip road leading to the westbound carriageway of the A50 from the roundabout junction of the A516 and A5132 Derby Road at Hilton;

“the works period”

means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Friday 10th January 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or a slip road.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
