ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M11 Motorway (Junction 14 Girton Interchange)
Northbound Exit Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic)
Order 2013**

Made - - - - *7th January 2013*

Coming into force - - *14th January 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M11 Motorway (“the M11”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M11 Motorway (Junction 14 Girton Interchange) Northbound Exit Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 14th January 2013.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 21st January 2013, or on any subsequent day (other than a Saturday or a Sunday) until works to replace a street lighting cable and undertake drainage investigation have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the exit slip road from the northbound carriageway of the M11 at Junction 14 Girton Interchange.

3. The provisions of article 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance, traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes.
