**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M602 Motorway (Junction 2, Eastbound Exit Slip Road)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - - *6<sup>th</sup> February 2013*

*Coming into force* - - - *10th February 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M602 Motorway and its slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those slip roads in the District of Salford in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M602 Motorway (Junction 2, Eastbound Exit Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 10th February 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M602 Motorway;

“work” means resurfacing and maintenance works on the motorway;

“the works period” means periods overnight between 2200 hours and 0700 hours (finishing at 0500 hours on weekday morning) during a period starting on Monday 11 February 2013 and ending on Saturday 2 March 2013. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“the slip road” means the exit road leading from the eastbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 2;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.
4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
