ROAD TRAFFIC

The A453 Trunk Road (Lockington, Leicestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic in Layby) Order 2013

Made - - - - 4th March 2013

Coming into force - - 11th March 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A453 Trunk Road (“the A453”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, near Lockington in the County of Leicestershire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A453 Trunk Road (Lockington, Leicestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic in Layby) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 11th March 2013.

2. In this Order:

“layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Thursday 14th March 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby adjacent to the southbound carriageway of the

A453 approximately 315 metres south of its roundabout junction with the M1, the A50 and the A6 at M1 Junction 24.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
