**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M69 Motorway (M69 Junction 1 to M1 Junction 21)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - *14th January 2013*

*Coming into force* - - *21st January 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M69 Motorway (“the M69”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of the that motorway and on two of those connecting roads in the County of Leicestershire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The M69 Motorway (M69 Junction 1 to M1 Junction 21) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 21st January 2013.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the M69 from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 1 to its roundabout junction with the A5460 and the exit and entry slip roads at M1 Junction 21;

“a slip road” means –  
(i) the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the M69 at Junction 1; and  
(ii) the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the M69 at Junction 2;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Saturday 26th January 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (c) being used for or in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
