The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Bournemouth) Regulations 2014

 Made
 15th May 2014

 Coming into force
 28th August 2014

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Bournemouth, Dorset by reason of flying displays that are scheduled to take place

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

Citation and commencement

during the period from 28th to 31st August 2014.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Bournemouth) Regulations 2014 and come into force on 28th August 2014.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3(1) all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time(**b**).

Restricted airspace

- **3.**—(1) Subject to paragraph (3)—
 - (a) between 1200 hours and 2000 hours on 28th August 2014,
 - (b) between 1100 hours and 2000 hours on 29th and 30th August 2014, and
 - (c) between 1100 hours and 1700 hours on 31st August 2014,

no aircraft is to fly below 5,500 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by straight lines joining successively the points referred to in paragraph (2).

- (2) The points mentioned in paragraph (1) are—
 - (a) 504304N 0015636W,
 - (b) 504405N 0014703W,
 - (c) 504016N 0014604W,
 - (d) 503914N 0015537W, and
 - (e) 504304N 0015636W.

⁽a) S.I. 2009/3015, to which there are amendments that are not relevant to these Regulations.

⁽b) Co-ordinated Universal Time (UTC) is one hour behind British Summer Time (BST).

- (3) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying—
 - (a) in accordance with a clearance issued by the air traffic control unit at either Bournemouth Airport or Southampton Airport, or
 - (b) with the permission of the Bournemouth Air Festival flying display director.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of the seafront at Bournemouth, Dorset during the Bournemouth Air Festival which will take place between 28th and 31st August 2014. A large number of aircraft will be involved in high-energy manoeuvres during the event. The Civil Aviation Authority considers that flying should be restricted during the air show in the vicinity of Bournemouth for reasons of public safety and this has been agreed with the Department for Transport.

The times mentioned in regulation 3(1) are Universal Co-ordinated Time (UTC), which is one hour behind British Summer Time.

In relation to the permission mentioned in regulation 3(3)(b), the Bournemouth Air Festival flying display director may be contacted on telephone number 07979 593941.

Full details of the airspace restrictions will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
