## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The A5 Trunk Road (Atherstone, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

*Made - - - 20th January 2014* 

Coming into force - - 27th January 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road ("the A5"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, at Atherstone in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Atherstone, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 27th January 2014.

## 2. In this Order –

"layby"

means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition "carriageway" means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

"the works period"

means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 3rd February 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed:

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby situated adjacent to the
  - a. northwest-bound carriageway of the A5 387 metres northwest of its junction with Drayton Lane; and
  - b. southeast-bound carriageway of the A5 622 metres northwest of its junction with Drayton Lane.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle
  - a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
  - b) being used in connection with the said works.
