**The M60 Motorway (Junction 11 Anticlockwise and Clockwise
Exit and Entry Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic)
Order 2014**

Made - - - - 23rd July 2014

Coming into force - - 31st July 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M60 Motorway and slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on four of those slip roads in the District of Salford in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) and 15(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M60 Motorway (Junction 11 Anticlockwise and Clockwise Exit and Entry Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 31st July 2014.

2. In this Order;

“the motorway” means the M60 Motorway;

“works” waste water upgrade works by United Utilities;

“the works period” means periods overnight between 2200 hours and 0500 hours during a period starting on Friday 1st August 2014 and ending on Tuesday 16th August 2016.

“the first slip road” means the exit slip road leading from the anticlockwise carriageway of the motorway at Junction 11;

“the second slip road” means the entry slip road leading to the anticlockwise carriageway of the motorway at Junction 11;

“the third slip road” means the exit slip road leading from the clockwise carriageway of the motorway at Junction 11;

“the fourth slip road” means the entry slip road leading to the clockwise carriageway of the motorway at Junction 11.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first, second, third and fourth slip roads.
4. The Secretary of State is satisfied that the execution of the said works will take longer than a period of 18 months starting on the date when this Order comes into force.
5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works or being used for winter maintenance purposes , or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
