ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M5 Motorway and A46 Trunk Road (M5 Junction 9,
Gloucestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - 24th November 2014

Coming into force - - 1st December 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M5 Motorway (“the M5”), the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of the A46 and two of those connecting roads, in the County of Gloucestershire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M5 Motorway and A46 Trunk Road (M5 Junction 9, Gloucestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 1st December 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction with the A46, the A438 Ashchurch Road and the slip roads leading to and from the northbound and southbound carriageways of the M5 (M5 Junction 9);

“a slip road” means the slip roads leading –
a) from the northbound carriageway of the M5 at Junction 9; and
b) from the southbound carriageway of the M5 at Junction 9;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 8th December 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- c) being used in connection with the said works or by, or with the permission of, a traffic officer in uniform.
