**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Royal Air Force  
Cosford) Regulations 2015**

*Made* - - - - *10th February 2015*

*Coming into force* - - *12th June 2015*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Royal Air Force Cosford, Shropshire by reason of the intended holding of a flying display that is scheduled to take place during the period from 12th to 14th June 2015.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009<sup>(a)</sup>.

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Royal Air Force Cosford) Regulations 2015 and come into force on 12th June 2015.

**Interpretation**

2. In regulation 3(1) all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time<sup>(b)</sup>.

**Restricted airspace**

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2)—

- (a) between 1300 hours and 1700 hours on 12th and 13th June 2015 respectively, and
- (b) between 1000 hours and 1700 hours on 14th June 2015,

no aircraft is to fly below 5,000 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by a circle having a radius of 6 nautical miles whose centre is at 523824N 0021819W.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying with the permission of the flying display director at Royal Air Force Cosford.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Royal Air Force Cosford, Shropshire during an air display for the general public that is scheduled to take place there during the period 12th to 14th June 2015. A large number of aircraft will be involved in high energy manoeuvres during the display. The Civil Aviation Authority's Safety and Airspace Regulation Group therefore considers that flying should be restricted in the vicinity of the displays for reasons of public safety and this has been agreed with the Department for Transport.

In relation to the permission mentioned in regulation 3(2), the Royal Air Force Cosford Air Show flying display director may be contacted on telephone 01902 377582.

The times mentioned in regulation 3(1) are Universal Co-ordinated Time (UTC), which for the purpose of these Regulations is one hour behind British Summer Time.

Full details of the Statutory Instrument will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
