The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Waddington) (Amendment) Regulations 2024

 Coming into force
 13th July 2024

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Waddington) Regulations 2024(a).

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016(**b**).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Waddington) (Amendment) Regulations 2024 and they come into force on 13th July 2024.

Amendment of the Regulations

- **2.**—(1) The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Waddington) Regulations 2024 are amended as follows.
 - (2) In regulation 2 for "3(2)" substitute "3(1)".
 - (3) For regulation 3(1) substitute—
 - "3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), between—
 - (a) 1030 hours and 1330 hours on 13th July 2024, and
 - (b) 1345 hours and 1615 hours on 3rd October 2024,

no aircraft is to fly below 9,300 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by a circle having a radius of 5 nautical miles whose centre is at 531001N 0003136W.".

EXPLANATORY NOTE
