The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Lyme Bay, English Channel) (Emergency) (Revocation) Regulations 2024

Made - - - - - - - - at 9.45 a.m. on 18th September 2024

Coming into force with immediate effect

The Secretary of State has decided that it is no longer considered necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the area specified in the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Lyme Bay, English Channel) (Emergency) Regulations 2024.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order $2016(\mathbf{a})$.

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Lyme Bay, English Channel) (Emergency) (Revocation) Regulations 2024 and they come into force with immediate effect.

Revocation of Regulations

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Lyme Bay, English Channel) (Emergency) Regulations 2024(**b**) are revoked.
