The Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs to the Danish Ambassador

Your Excellency,

Foreign Office, 11th November, 1949.

In my note of 26th October, 1948,⁽¹⁾ I had the honour to forward to your Excellency an Annex containing the names of territories to which, on and after 10th November, 1948, Danish subjects would be free to travel without a visa, provided that they were furnished with a valid Danish passport.

2. I have now the honour to request that Kenya may be added to the above-mentioned Annex, between Jamaica and Leeward Islands, and to add that Danish subjects may forthwith travel to Kenya without a visa, provided that they hold a valid Danish passport.

3. Your Excellency will, I know, understand that the provisions of paragraph 3 of my note of 26th October, 1948, continue to be applicable.

4. I have the honour to request your Excellency to be so good as to acknowledge the receipt of this communication.

The Danish Ambassador presents his compliments to His Britannic Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs and has the honour to acknowledge with thanks the receipt of Mr. Ernest Bevin's note of the 11th instant concerning the addition of Kenya to the Annex to the Foreign Secretary's note of 26th October, 1948, listing the names of territories to which holders of valid Danish passports would be free to travel without a visa on and after 10th November, 1948, and has noted that the provisions of paragraph 3 of the last-mentioned note continue to be applicable.

Count Reventlow begs to add that the information contained in Mr. Ernest Bevin's note has been transmitted to the Ministry for Foreign Affairs in Copenhagen.
