# EXCHANGE OF LETTERS AMENDING THE TRADE AGREEMENT OF 10th AUGUST, 1951, BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF CUBA

Dr. Vargas Gomez (Cuban Trade Delegation) to Mr. Stacy (Board of Trade)

Embajada de Cuba, Gran Bretaña.

Estimado Señor Stacy,

1 de setiembre de 1951.

Con referencia al Acuerdo Comercial concluido entre nuestros dos Gobiernos el dia 10 de agosto de 1951, deseo obtener la conformidad del Gobierno del Reino Unido para la modificacion de la Partida 223 de la Lista anexa al Acuerdo, de modo que quede redactada en la forma siguiente:

"223.—Máquinas y aparatos eléctricos, incluyendo las piezas sueltas y accesorios para los mismos no tarifados especialmente:—

A.—Lavadoras eléctricas

Ad val. 8%

B.—Los demás, incluyendo los teléfonos y las pilas, pero excluyendo las planchas eléctricas y los acumuladores ...

Ad val. 11.9%."

Si el Gobierno del Reino Unido esta conforme con esta proposicion, me permito sugerirle que la presente Nota, y la respuesta de usted, sean consideradas como la debida constancia del acuerdo alcanzado entre nuestros dos Gobiernos sobre esta materia.

With reference to the Trade Agreement concluded between our two Governments on 10th August, 1951,(1) I seek the concurrence of the United Kingdom Government in the amendment of Item 223 of the Schedule to the Agreement so that it may read as follows:—

"223.—Electrical machinery and apparatus, including loose parts and accessories for the same, not specifically classified:—

A.—Electric washing machines

Ad val. 8%

B.—Others, including telephones and batteries, but excluding electric irons and storage batteries ....

Ad val. 11.9%."

Dear Dr. Vargas Gomez, 1st September, 1951.

I refer to your letter of to-day's date, in which you propose that Item 223 of the Schedule to the Trade Agreement concluded between our two Governments on 10th August, 1951, should be amended to read as follows:—
