**AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR COOPERATION ON THE
CIVIL USES OF ATOMIC ENERGY BETWEEN THE
GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT
BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE
GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**

The Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, on its own behalf and on behalf of the United Kingdom Atomic Energy Authority, and the Government of the United States of America (including the United States Atomic Energy Commission),

Desiring to extend the term of the Agreement for Cooperation on the Civil Uses of Atomic Energy (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement for Cooperation") signed between them at Washington on June 15, 1955⁽¹⁾, as amended by the Notes signed October 20, 1955 and November 3, 1955⁽²⁾, the Agreement signed at Washington on June 13, 1956⁽³⁾, as modified by the Agreement signed at Washington on July 3, 1958⁽⁴⁾, as amended by the Agreement signed at Washington on June 5, 1963⁽⁵⁾, and as amended by the Agreement signed at Washington on June 29, 1964⁽⁶⁾ ;

Have agreed as follows :

ARTICLE I

Article XI of the Agreement for Cooperation, as amended, is modified by changing the word " ten " which appears before the word " years " at the end thereof to read " eleven ".

ARTICLE II

This Amendment, which shall be regarded as an integral part of the Agreement for Cooperation, shall enter into force on the date on which each Government shall have received from the other Government written notification that it has complied with all statutory and constitutional requirements for the entry into force of this Amendment⁽⁷⁾ and shall remain in force for the period of the Agreement for Cooperation, as hereby amended.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned, duly authorized, have signed this Amendment.

DONE at Washington this fifteenth day of July, 1965 in two original texts.
