BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF SWEDEN PROLONGING THE AGREEMENT OF 20 SEPTEMBER 1957 FOR CO-OPERATION IN THE PEACEFUL USES OF ATOMIC ENERGY

Her Majesty's Ambassador at Stockholm to the Acting Minister for Foreign Affairs of Sweden

No. 1245 Your Excellency,

British Embassy, Stockholm, 19 September, 1967.

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement signed at Stockholm on the 20th of September, 1957(1) between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of Sweden for Co-operation in the Peaceful Uses of Atomic Energy. Under the terms of Article X thereof, the Agreement is due to terminate on the 19th of September, 1967 but may be renewed from time to time for such periods as may be agreed between the Contracting Parties.

Accordingly, I have the honour to propose that the Agreement shall be extended for a period of ten years from to-day's date. If this proposal is acceptable to the Government of Sweden, I have the honour to suggest that this Note, together with Your Excellency's reply to that effect, shall be regarded as effecting a prolongation of the Agreement until the 19th of September, 1977.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurance of my highest consideration.
