- (b) On transfer, the above mentioned item shall be treated in all respect as if it were supplied from the United Kingdom to Switzerland pursuant to the Agreement between the Government of the Unite Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Confederation of Switzerland for Co-operation in the Peaceful
