CONCERNING A GRANT BY THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND TO THE GOVERNMENT OF PAKISTAN (UNITED KINGDOM/PAKISTAN (TARBELA No. 9) AGREEMENT 1975)

Sir,

United Kingdom/Pakistan (Tarbela No. 9) Agreement 1975

- 1. I have the honour to state that in accordance with the provisions of the Tarbela Development Fund (Supplemental) Agreement 1975(1) (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement"), and in particular of Section 1.01 (b) of the Agreement, the Government of the United Kingdom proposes to make available to the Government of Pakistan by way of grant a sum not exceeding £2,500,000 (two million five hundred thousand pounds sterling) (hereinafter referred to as "the Grant") as a contribution to the cost of the completion of the Tarbela Dam project and to propose that for the purposes of the Grant the following arrangements shall be made—
 - (i) The Grant shall be used to reimburse the Tarbela Development Fund (hereinafter referred to as "the Fund"), as referred to in the Agreement for payments made from the Fund by the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development acting as Administrator of the Fund (hereinafter referred to as "the Administrator") in respect of goods and services required for the purposes set out in paragraph 1.07 (a) of the Agreement.
 - (ii) Drawings from the Grant for this purpose shall be made according to procedures which shall be arranged between the Government of the United Kingdom and the Administrator. These procedures will be notified to the Government of Pakistan by the Administrator.
 - (iii) The Government of Pakistan shall make such arrangements with the Administrator as are necessary to the effective carrying out of the procedures agreed under the terms of sub paragraph (ii) above.
 - (iv) Should any funds become repayable under the terms of sections 1.08 and 1.09 of the Agreement, they shall, under section 1.08 (b) (ii) (2), be repaid by the Administrator to the Government of the United Kingdom as if they were repayments under section 1.08 (b) (ii) (1).

2. If the foregoing arrangements are acceptable to the Government of Pakistan, I have the honour to propose that this present Note together with your reply in that sense shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments which shall enter into force on the date of your reply and shall be known as the United Kingdom/Pakistan (Tarbela No. 9) Agreement 1975.

I avail myself of the opportunity to renew to you, Sir, the assurance of my highest consideration.
