1. I have the honour to refer to the Exchange of Notes between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of Malawi dated 14 June 1976, which constituted the British Expatriates Supplementation (Malawi) (Continuance) Agreement 1971/76<sup>(1)</sup> (hereinafter called "the Agreement"), and to discussions which have taken place between our respective Governments concerning the employment of British staff in additional schools in Malawi.
2. At the request of the Government of Malawi, the Government of the United Kingdom propose that the nine schools listed in the Annex hereto should also be added to the Second Annex of the Agreement.
3. If the proposal set out in this Note is acceptable to the Government of Malawi I have the honour to propose that this Note and your reply shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments, amending the British Expatriates Supplementation (Malawi) (Continuance) Agreement 1971/76, which shall be referred to as the British Expatriates Supplementation (Malawi) (Continuance) Agreement 1971/76 (Third Amendment) 1977<sup>(2)</sup>, and which shall be deemed to have entered into force on 1 August 1977.
