AMENDMENTS⁽¹⁾
TO ANNEXES I AND II TO THE CONVENTION ON THE
PREVENTION OF MARINE POLLUTION BY DUMPING OF
WASTES AND OTHER MATTER⁽²⁾ CONCERNING LISTS
OF SUBSTANCES

Paragraph 5 of Annex I shall be amended as follows :

“ 5 Crude oil and its wastes, refined petroleum products, petroleum distillate residues, and any mixtures containing any of these, taken on board for the purpose of dumping.”

The following paragraph shall be added to Annex II :

“ F Substances which, though of a non-toxic nature, may become harmful due to the quantities in which they are dumped, or which are liable to seriously reduce amenities.”

⁽¹⁾ These amendments were adopted at the Fifth Consultative Meeting of Contracting Parties by LDC Resolution 12(v) on 24 September 1980, at which time it was resolved that 1 December 1980 be treated as the date of approval of the amendments for the purposes of Articles XIV(4)(a) and XV(2) of the Convention. The amendments entered into force on 11 March 1981 for all parties except the Federal Republic of Germany and Japan.
