**DECISION**  
**OF THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GOVERNMENTS OF**  
**THE MEMBER STATES OF THE EUROPEAN COAL AND**  
**STEEL COMMUNITY, MEETING WITHIN THE COUNCIL,**  
**ALLOCATING TO THAT COMMUNITY SUPPLEMENTARY**  
**REVENUE FOR 1981**

The Representatives of the Governments of the Member States of the European Coal and Steel Community, meeting within the Council,

Whereas, in the present situation of the coal and steel industry, the financial means at the Commission's disposal to accomplish its task under the Treaty establishing the European Coal and Steel Community<sup>(1)</sup> must be increased; whereas the Member States should accordingly allocate to it supplementary revenue as an exceptional measure;

In agreement with the Commission,

Have decided as follows:

**ARTICLE 1**

Member States shall pay to the European Coal and Steel Community the sum of 50 million ECU for the financial year 1981 as an exceptional contribution.

**ARTICLE 2**

The contributions to be made by the Member States shall be:

**ARTICLE 3**

The sums to be paid by each Member State shall be payable on 1 December 1981.

In certain Member States the undertaking of the obligation deriving from this Decision is subject to the subsequent necessary Parliamentary approval.

Payments may be made either in ECU or in national currencies at the ECU exchange rate obtaining on the day of payment.<sup>(2)</sup>

#### ARTICLE 4

The Member States shall, in close co-operation with the Commission, take all the necessary measures to ensure the application of the foregoing provisions.

#### ARTICLE 5

The Member States shall make the arrangements necessary for the execution of this Decision.
