#### **EXCHANGE OF NOTES**

BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE GAMBIA AMENDING AND EXTENDING THE OVERSEAS SERVICE (THE GAMBIA) (CONTINUANCE) AGREEMENT 1971/76

Sir,

I have the honour to refer to the Overseas Service (The Gambia) (Continuance) Agreement 1971/76(1) hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement"), and to propose that the Agreement be amended as follows:

- (a) amend the beginning of subparagraph 4(b) of paragraph 1 to read "the amount paid by the Government of The Gambia in providing . . . ";
- (b) subparagraph 5(d) of paragraph 1 is deleted;
- (c) in subparagraphs 7 and 8 of paragraph 1, delete the punctuation and words ", gratuity";
- (d) in subparagraph 15 of paragraph 1, delete the words and figures "31 March 1981" and substitute therefore the words and figures "31 March 1986".

If these proposals are acceptable to the Government of the Republic of The Gambia, I have the honour to suggest that this Note and your reply shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments which shall enter into force on 31 March 1981 and which shall be cited, together with the Agreement, as the Overseas Service (The Gambia) Agreement 1971/81.
