Your Excellency,

British Expatriates Supplementation (Swaziland) Agreement 1976/81

I have the honour to refer to the British Expatriates Supplementation (Swaziland) Agreement 1976<sup>(1)</sup> as amended by the British Expatriates Supplementation (Swaziland) Agreement 1976 Amendment 1977<sup>(1)</sup>, (hereinafter referred to as "The Agreement") and to propose that the Agreement be amended as follows:—

- (a) In sub-paragraph 3 of paragraph 1, delete the words and figures "31 March 1981" and substitute therefor the words and figures "31 March 1986";
- (b) Add the following to the list of employing authorities in the second Annex to the Agreement:—

Small Scale Enterprises Development Corporation.

If the proposal is acceptable to the Government of the Kingdom of Swaziland, I have the honour to suggest that this Note and your reply shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments which shall enter into force on 31 March 1981 and which shall be cited, together with the Agreement, as the British Expatriates Supplementation (Swaziland) Agreement 1976/81.
