UNDERTAKING

MADE BY THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GOVERNMENTS OF THE MEMBER STATES OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY MEETING WITHIN THE COUNCIL ON 23 AND 24 APRIL 1985 IN BRUSSELS TO MAKE PAYMENTS TO THE COMMUNITY TO FINANCE THE GENERAL BUDGET FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 1985.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

1. The Representatives of the Governments of the Member States, meeting within the Council, undertake to pay the following amount to the Community to finance the 1985 budget:

2. This amount is divided up among the Member States as follows:

3. The amounts paid by each Member State constitute non-repayable advances.

4. The Representatives of the Governments of the Member States note that in certain Member States the payment of these amounts in pursuance of the undertaking will involve the completion of certain internal procedures ⁽¹⁾
