Note no. 61

Her Britannic Majesty's Embassy present their compliments to the Royal Ministry of Foreign Affairs and have the honour to confirm that the United Kingdom agrees to ensure that arrangements are provided for the disposal of the "Brent Spar", whose owners accept that they have a statutory duty to provide for its satisfactory disposal, to which the usual statutory procedures will have to be applied. The "Brent Spar" is still, and will remain, registered as a United Kingdom offshore installation. Its eventual disposal will not become a Norwegian responsibility. The United Kingdom Government will give any permits and consents necessary for the removal of the "Brent Spar" from waters under Norwegian jurisdiction when, in accordance with the Norwegian authorities' decision, the date for temporary mooring in Norway has expired.

If the content of this Note is acceptable to the Government of Norway this Note and the reply of the Government of Norway will constitute an agreement between our two Governments.

Her Britannic Majesty's Embassy avail themselves of this opportunity to renew to the Royal Ministry of Foreign Affairs the assurance of their highest consideration.
