## EXCHANGE OF NOTES BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF NORWAY AMENDING THE AGREEMENT RELATING TO THE EXPLOITATION OF THE MURCHISON FIELD RESERVOIR AND THE OFFTAKE OF PETROLEUM THEREFROM SIGNED AT OSLO ON 16 OCTOBER 1979<sup>1</sup>

Her Majesty's Ambassador at Oslo to the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Norway

British Embassy Oslo 9 August 1999

Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the negotiations between representatives of our two Governments concerning the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Kingdom of Norway relating to the exploitation of the Murchison Field Reservoir and the Offtake of Petroleum therefrom, signed in Oslo on 16 October 1979 (the Agreement) and to propose that the following amendment be made to the Agreement:

Paragraph 2 of Article 3 of the English version of the Agreement shall be deleted and replaced with the following text:

(2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1) of this Article, no request for a review of the limits of the Murchison Field Reservoir and the total amount of the Reserves and the apportionment of the Reserves or any of them agreed or determined under this Agreement may be submitted in order to arrive at a redetermination with a scheduled date later than 1 January 1995.

Paragraph 2 of Article 3 of the Norwegian version of the Agreement shall be deleted and replaced with the following text:

2. Uten hensyn til punkt 1 i denne artikkel, kan det ikke fremsettes noen anmodning om en ny vurdering av grensene for Murchison-reservoaret, de samlede reserver og fordelingen av reservene som omforenet eller fastsatt i henhold til denne overenskomst, med det formål å foreta en justering av disse eller enkelte av dem med fastsatt tidspunkt senere en 1. januar 1995.

If the foregoing proposals are acceptable to the Government of the Kingdom of Norway, I have the honour to propose that this Note, together with your reply to that effect, shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments which shall enter into force on the date of your reply.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurances of my highest consideration.
