**TERMINATION OF THE PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES GRANTED BY THE  
HOST NATION TO THE JOINT UNDERTAKING**

I have the honour to refer to discussions which have taken place between representatives of the Commission and the United Kingdom Government concerning the winding-up of the Joint European Torus (JET) Joint Undertaking.

In the light of those discussions I have the honour to propose that from the date of the dissolution of the Joint Undertaking, the Agreement with EURATOM concerning the privileges of the Joint European Torus (JET) constituted by an Exchange of Letters between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Commission of the European Communities dated 3 May 1978<sup>1</sup> shall be terminated.

If the above proposal is acceptable to the European Atomic Energy Community I have the honour to propose that this letter and your reply to that effect shall constitute an Agreement between the United Kingdom Government and the European Atomic Energy Community in this matter which shall enter into force on the date of dissolution of the Joint Undertaking.

I have the honour to renew the assurances of my highest consideration.
