**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

The M4 Motorway (Junction 33,  
Capel Llanilltern, Cardiff,  
Eastbound On -Slip Road)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles)  
Order 2012

*Made* 19 June 2012

*Coming into force* 29 June 2012

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the London to South Wales Motorway (M4) (hereinafter referred to as “the motorway”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the motorway should be prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers (2) make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 29 June 2012 and its title is The M4 Motorway (Junction 33, Capel Llanilltern, Cardiff, Eastbound On-Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2012 .

2. (1) In this Order :

“exempted vehicle” (*“cerbyd esempt”*) means any vehicle being used in connection with the works giving rise to this Order and by the emergency services;

“the length of the motorway” (*“y darn o’r draffordd”*) means the entire length of the eastbound on slip road of the motorway at Junction 33, Capel Llanilltern, in the City and County of Cardiff;

“works period” (*“cyfnod y gwaith”*) means the period commencing at 20.00 hours on 29 June 2012 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

3. Subject to the provisions of article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to be driven in the length of the motorway.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

5. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 12 months.
